Fresh and fine-bubbled — green apple, white peach, gentle yeasty note. Great aperitivo energy.
- ◆ NV La Spinetta Moscato d'Asti, Piemonte, IT 24 | 120
Iconic Piedmontese producer. Low alcohol, gently sparkling — apricot, orange blossom and honey. Perfect pre-dinner.
- ◆ NV Veuve Cliquot, Champagne, FR 25 | 145
Classic grower Champagne energy — brioche, baked apple and citrus peel. Creamy mousse, fine bead and a long chalky finish.
- ◆ '24 'Tarot' Prosecco, SA 12 | 59
Iconic Piedmontese producer. Low alcohol, gently sparkling — apricot, orange blossom and honey. Perfect pre-dinner.

ROSÉ, SKIN & ORANGE

- ◆ '24 Eldorado Rd. Luminoso, Alpine Valley, VIC 16 | 80
Pale salmon, dry and delicate. Strawberry, watermelon and a savoury herb finish.
- ◆ '24 Alpha Dice & Box 'Palmetto', Multiregion, SA 13 | 65
Juicy and bright with watermelon, blood orange and soft spice. Dry, crunchy and dangerously easy to drink.

WHITE

- ◆ '23 Silent Noise MOFO, McLaren Vale, SA 20 | 100
Left-field white blend with skin contact influence. Textured, aromatic and a little funky in the best way.
- ◆ '25 Babich Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, NZ 11 | 52
Passionfruit, lime and fresh-cut grass — clean, crisp and reliable by the glass.
- ◆ '25 Brindabella Hills Riesling, Canberra, ACT 15 | 75
Classic cool-climate Riesling — lime zest, green apple and floral lift. Bone dry with bright acidity and a clean mineral finish.
- ◆ '24 La Cantina Pinot Grigio, King Valley, VIC 13 | 65
Light and lively King Valley grigio. Pear, white nectarine and a gentle almond finish.
- ◆ '24 Pizzini Verduzzo, King Valley, VIC 15 | 75
Rare Italian variety grown in King Valley. Fragrant and fresh — lemon, white flowers and subtle phenolic grip.
- ◆ '24 Tenuta Ulisse Pecorino, Abruzzo, IT 15 | 75
Bright, food-friendly Abruzzo white — golden apple, fennel and a savoury, almost nutty finish.

Cool-climate icon with white peach, citrus and gentle oak spice. Fresh, textural and modern with balanced natural acidity.

- ◆ '24 Philip Shaw Pinot Noir, Orange NSW 17 | 84
Bright and perfumed — cherry, cranberry and soft baking spice. Light-bodied, silky and easy-drinking with subtle earthy notes.
- ◆ '23 Eldorado Rd. Quasimodo, Alpine Valley, VIC 16 | 80
Nero d'Avola, Durif, Shiraz blend — earthy and wild with dark berry and leather.
- ◆ '24 La Cantina Saperavi, King Valley, VIC 18 | 90
For the Shiraz Lovers, Georgian grape in King Valley. Inky, structured — dark plum, blackcurrant and a firm grippy finish.
- ◆ '23 Soul Growers Equilibrium GSM, Barossa, SA 15 | 75
Grenache, Shiraz, Mourvèdre from old Barossa vines. Bright red fruit, pepper and savoury spice.
- ◆ '24 Rocca Ventosa Montepulciano, Abruzzo, IT 12 | 59
Rustic and generous. Black cherry, dried herbs and a firm tannin structure. The carafe wine — unpretentious, goes with everything.

Classic Sangiovese — cherry, dried roses and earthy minerality. Balanced, food-friendly and honest.

- ◆ '15 Dom Perignon, Champagne, FR 620
Iconic vintage Champagne — citrus, toasted almond and pastry richness. Powerful yet precise with creamy texture and incredible length.
- ◆ NV Lallier 'R.020', Champagne, FR 165
Refined and expressive Champagne — lemon zest, green apple and brioche. Fine mousse, bright acidity and a long elegant finish

ROSÉ

- ◆ '24 Ch. D'Eclans 'Whispering Angel', Provence FR 115
Elegant and delicate — raspberry, watermelon and soft floral notes. Silky texture with crisp acidity and a clean mineral finish.

Classic Provence rosé — strawberry, white peach and citrus peel. Dry, pale and effortlessly refreshing.

True Chablis — unoaked, mineral-driven. Oyster shell, lemon and green apple. Excellent with seafood.
- ◆ '22 Pizzini Attento Pinot Grigio, King Valley, VIC 155
Pizzini's premium grigio — barrel-fermented with more weight and texture. Spice, pear and a toasty finish.
- ◆ '20 Pieropan Soave Classico, Veneto, ITA 375
Legendary producer, legendary region. Volcanic minerality, white blossom and a piercingly pure finish.
- ◆ '21 Levantine Hill Chardonnay, Yarra Valley, VIC 225
Luxury Yarra Chardonnay from the Melting Pot vineyard. Opulent peach, hazelnut and cream with genuine complexity.
- ◆ '24 Giant Steps Chardonnay, Yarra Valley, VIC 130
Phil Sexton's benchmark Yarra Chardonnay. Finesse over power — white peach, melon and creamy oak with restraint.
- ◆ '23 Indigo Secret Village Chardonnay Beechworth, VIC 125
Wild-fermented Beechworth Chardonnay. Nutty, creamy and complex with white peach and a long savoury finish.
- ◆ '23 Shaw + Smith M3 Chardonnay, Adelaide Hills, SA 165
Astone-cold Adelaide Hills classic. Grapefruit, white peach, impeccable winemaking.
- ◆ '24 Ross Hill Pinnacle Chardonnay, Orange, NSW 135
Single-vineyard Orange Chardonnay at altitude. Grapefruit, oak spice and creamy texture.

Prestigious Yarra Valley Pinot. Silky, complex and age-worthy — violet, dark cherry, truffle and spice.
- ◆ '24 Kyneton Ridge Skipping Rabbit Pinot Noir 105
Macedon Ranges, VIC
Cool-climate. Red cherry, dried violets, clove and a savoury forest floor finish.
- ◆ '23 Riposte The Sabre Pinot Noir, Adelaide Hills, SA 125
Tim Knappstein's Hills Pinot. Elegant and restrained — dark cherry, red plum and fine-grained tannin.
- ◆ '22 Pressing Matters Pinot Noir, Coal River, TAS 195
Tasmanian Pinot from one of the island's best. Intense, perfumed and long — a serious wine for a serious occasion.

Oldvine Shiraz from elevated Alpine Valleys. Dark plum, tobacco, tar and exceptional depth.

Heathcote Shiraz from a region born for the variety. Dense and savoury — plum, pepper and great length.
- ◆ '20 Moscone Barbaresco DOCG, Piemonte, IT 315
Nebbiolo from Barbaresco DOCG. Tar, roses, cherry and leather with a long tannic structure.
- ◆ '12 D. D'Angelo Aglianico del Vulture, Basilicata, IT 410
The cellarlist centrepiece. Iron, dried herb, brooding dark fruit from a master of the south. Extraordinary.

SWEET & FORTIFIED

- ◆ NV Rockford Frontignac, Barossa Valley, SA 26 | 200
A Barossa icon. Rich, musky and honeyed — a fortified style that's complex and unique. A fitting finale.
- ◆ NV La Spinetta Moscato d'Asti, Piemonte, IT 120
Gently sparkling and low alcohol. Fragrant apricots, orange blossom and honey. Refreshing after-dinner.
